This notice is to allow you to request a second public hearing be held to consider the land use cases cited below. To request hearing is to be held, it will be before County Hearing Officer Joe Turner.

If a second hearing is requested by any party, it will be held on May 3, 2019, at 9 a.m. or soon thereafter, in Room 103 at the Land Use Planning Division office located at 1600 SE 190th Ave, Portland.

LOCATION: 8945 NW Kaiser Rd, Portland

BASE ZONE: Multiple Use Agriculture-20 zone (MUA-20)

OVERLAYS: Significant Environmental Concerns for Habitat (SEC-h)

PROPOSAL: Applicant is requesting a Variance to the street side yard and to the rear yard to allow existing accessory buildings to remain in their present location in the Multiple Use Agriculture-20 zone. In addition, the applicant is seeking approval of a Significant Environmental Concern for wildlife habitat permit to allow the existing six accessory buildings that have been constructed without review. An Accessory Use

Determination is required to authorize at least one of the structures.
