

Thank you for your response to our request for information on the Centurylink land line outages that have been going on throughout December. We heard from many and their stories of up and down outages. The experiences were similar (all in December) and diverse (when they went down, when service came back). It is also frustrating that there are many in our rural area whose only connection option is their landline. We did hear of some possible causes from a discussion a technician had with a neighbor. That was, that the Burlington switch had a bad power surge in early December that damaged equipment. They had to limp by while waiting for replacement equipment. The system is up and running for now but they are still checking on possible further problems. With that in mind, the technician was clear to say that he cannot guarantee we have a permanent fix even now.



**Community Wildfire Defense Grant Money Sought**

West Multnomah SWCD has submitted an application for the Community Wildfire Defense Grant offered through the US Forest Service, in partnership with Ash Creek Forest Management, Portland Fire & Rescue, Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue, and many local community groups including the Forest Park North & South and Skyline Ridge Firewise Communities, Skyline Ridge Neighborhood Association, Skyline Ridge NET, and the Skyline Grange. The goal for seeking this funding is to support communities across the Tualatin Mountains in their efforts to improve wildfire resiliency and forest health and increase community awareness around emergency preparation and wildfire risk reduction actions. The US Forest Service (the agency running this grant program) expects to notify applicants of their final decision by February or March of 2024. This is a very competitive national grant, but there will be additional rounds of this funding opportunity to apply for in future years if the local community does not receive funding this year.

BASE ZONE: Rural Residential (R/R)

OVERLAYS: Significant Environmental Concern for wildlife habitat and view (SEC-h, &amp; SEC-v) and Geologic Hazards (GH)

PROPOSAL: Request for a Type II Significant Environmental Concern for Scenic Views &amp; Wildlife Habitat permits for an addition to an existing single-family dwelling.


DECISION: Approved with Conditions. This decision is final at the close of the appeal period, unless appealed. The deadline for filing an appeal is January 11, 2024 at 4 p.m.

OPPORTUNITY TO APPEAL: The appeal form is available at [www.multco.us/landuse/application-materials-and-forms](http://www.multco.us/landuse/application-materials-and-forms). Appeal requires a \$250 fee and must state the specific legal grounds on which it is based. This decision is not appealable to the Land Use Board of Appeals until all local appeals are exhausted.
