

**ROCKY POINT ROAD REPAIR PROGRESS** I reached out to Sarah Hurwitz with Multnomah County asking if they could provide any information on the status of Rocky Point Road repairs. She responded - in order to open the road to traffic as soon as possible, crews will be removing the damaged asphalt and the road will temporarily have gravel. This will allow the road to reopen to traffic sooner. Their hope is to have


