CPR/FIRST AID TRAINING @ GRANGE

Deadline to Register this Wed., Oct 18
 This full day course is being offered to Skyline area residents as part of the joint effort between Skyline Grange, Skyline Ridge Neighbors, and Skyline Ridge NET to encourage area residents to be prepared for emergencies. This course is offered biennially to our community, and again will be taught by Cascade Training Center.

WHEN: Saturday, October 28, 2023
 TIME: 8:45 am – 4:15 p.m.
 WHERE: Skyline Grange, 11275 NW Skyline Blvd., Portland 97231
 CONTENT: Basic 1st aid, CPR for infants to adults, and the use of an AED defibrillator. You will receive a CPR certification card.
 COST: Tuition is \$85, plus \$8 for the workbook if you do not have the required copy of 2021 AHA Heartsaver Workbook. SRN will subsidize up to \$43 of the cost for residents living within its boundaries. FALL BACKYARD BURN SEASON IS NOW, BUT CALL BEFORE YOU BURN

Residential "backyard" outdoor burning is limited to approved burn days and hours during the spring (March 1-June 15) and fall (October 1- December 15). This allows for limited outdoor burning of yard debris, leaves and tree trimmings in accordance with DEQ Rules and ODF rules.
 a. Check the TVF&R Outdoor Burning Map at Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue Burn Restrictions (arcgis.com) to see if your address is allowed residential backyard debris burning.
 b. Next, if burning is allowed in your area, find out whether it is an approved burn day by calling TVF&R's Burn Message at 503-259-1789. Call before you burn!
 c. Days and hours approved depend upon air quality and fire risks.
 d. Unauthorized burning during a burn ban may be subject to enforcement.
 e. Never leave a fire unattended. Escaped fire is a leading cause of wildfires in Oregon.
