FOREST PARK NEIGHBORHOOD MEETING RE: PGE **HARBORTON PROJECT**

When: January 2 Time: 7 pm

Where: Skyline Grange, 11275 NW Skyline Blvd

Forest Park to build new transmission lines. The threat is real, and the harm would be severe. PGE also plans two more projects in the park in the next few years -- one would remove another 15 acres of trees. All these project are in the North Unit of the park that is protected for wildlife habitat with the goal of growing it into an ancient forest. A hearings officer will be reviewing this application from PGE at the end of January. You are invited to a meeting January 2, 2025 at 7PM at Skyline Grange, 11275 NW Skyline Blvd for local residents to learn about the project and ask questions. You can expect an overview of the project, Q&A, and information about how to submit comments for the January 29 hearing.
