Due to the concerns reported about increased crime in our neighborhood, we're going to start a new project to promote community safety through personal connections and awareness. The project will help us: rebuild neighborly relationships as we emerge from Covid, help each other deal with emergencies ranging from snowstorms to big damaging earthquakes, and reduce wildfire risks.  DECISION: Approved with Conditions. This decision is final unless appealed by Monday, June 27, 2022. An appeal requires a \$250 fee and must state the specific legal grounds on which it is based.

### Paralyzed man to attempt world record on Sauvie Island

On Tuesday, June 21 Ian Mackay will attempt a world record on Sauvie Island, for the greatest distance covered in 24 hours by a motorized wheelchair. Mackay is the founder and executive director of Ian's Ride, a nonprofit based out of Washington. Mackay, who was an avid cyclist, was left paralyzed from the neck down after a 2008 bicycle crash. There will be no road closures for this event. Multnomah County wants to remind everyone on the road to be alert and keep an eye out for Mackay. There will be two message boards on each ramp alerting traffic coming off the Sauvie Island Bridge. A truck with warning lights will also be following Mackay at all times.
