## TOXIC ALGAE ON SAUVIE ISLAND

Thursday, July 27, 2023. Oregon Health Authority issued a health advisory for Sauvie Island due to toxic algae -- at Aarons Lake, Pete's Slough, & Sturgeon Lake. Do not swim or play in these waters and keep pets away. Ingesting the water can cause serious illness. Check current advisories at [www.bit.ly/3Cdm9ZV](http://www.bit.ly/3Cdm9ZV).

## A Neighbor Reports:

"There has been a person wandering through the woods and approaching homes on mid McNamee Rd. He was confronted by a neighbor [on 7/24/23] and said he was looking for water. Another neighbor reports missing eggs from their coop. Please be on extra alert. He is believed to still be in the area [7/25/23] as water was left running outside at the neighbors' home. Description: White male, maybe about 30 years old, 5'9", 150 lb, slender, bald with brown hair on the fringes, facial hair, wearing gray sweatpants and carrying a walking stick, shirtless or wearing an open loose fitting shirt."

## When to call 911 source:

If there is an immediate threat to life or property, call 9-1-1. If there is NOT an immediate threat to life or property, call 503-823-3333. 3-1-1 is the first point of contact for non-emergency situation where Police, Fire, Ambulance, and Portland Street Response are not needed to be dispatched.
