PROPOSAL: Applicant requests a Lot of Record Verification, SEC-v permit, GH, and a Type 1 SEC-h permit to replace a single-family dwelling and attached deck that were damaged by fire, and the retroactive review of ground disturbance within the GH overlay not previously reviewed by the County. The proposed development is not within the SEC for streams overlay, and therefore, an SEC-s permit is not required for the project.
