SKYLINE GRANGE NEWS CPR/FIRST AID TRAINING @ GRANGE

This full day course is being offered to Skyline area residents as part of the joint effort between Skyline Grange, Skyline Ridge NET, and Skyline Ridge Neighbors to encourage area residents to be prepared for emergencies. Emergencies can range from a major earthquake, a wildland fire, a stranger needing CPR, or a babysitter needing to give basic first aid. The course will be taught by Cascade Training Center. To encourage your participation, SRN will pay part of the tuition for residents living within its boundaries.

WHEN: Saturday, October 16, 2021
TIME: 8:45 am – 4:30 pm
WHERE: Skyline Grange, 11275 NW Skyline Blvd., Portland 97231
COST: Tuition will be \$103. SRN will subsidize up to \$45 of the cost for residents living within its boundaries. To check if you live within SRN boundaries, refer to [Boundary Map - SRN \(srnpdx.org\)](#)
LUNCH: A healthy salad bar will be provided by Skyline Grange
SAFETY: Adequate masking & distancing will be maintained. Proof of vaccinations for COVID is required.
REGISTER: Capacity is limited, so register early. Email skylinegrange894@msn.com to request an application.
DEADLINE: Registration and payment must be received no later than Friday, October 1, 2021. Mailing instructions are in the application.

EXTREME HEAT FORECASTED THIS UPCOMING WEEK

Skyline Ridge NET urges residents to take the following pre-cautions:

1. Check often on house-bound and vulnerable neighbors.
2. Drink lots of non-alcoholic, caffeine-free beverages. Drink even if you are not thirsty.
3. Choose to wear light colored, loose-fitting cotton.
4. Do not run fans in a room with the windows shut – you are only circulating hot air.
5. Stay out of direct sunlight and seek shade. Wear a wide-brimmed hat to create your own shade. Wear sunscreen.
6. Wear lightweight, light-colored, loose-fitting clothing that permits sweat to evaporate.

14-DAY OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT: 21530 NW Gilkison Rd

LOCATION: 21530 NW Gilkison Rd, Scappoose, OR
BASE ZONE: Rural Residential (RR)
OVERLAYS: Significant Environmental Concern – wildlife habitat (SEC-h) and streams (SEC-s), and Geologic Hazards (GH)
DECISION: The subject property is a Lot of Record in its current configuration.
OPPORTUNITY TO APPEAL: This decision is final at the close of the appeal period, unless appealed. The deadline for filing an appeal is Monday, August 16, 2021 at 4 p.m. An appeal requires a \$250 fee and must state the specific legal grounds on which it is based. To obtain forms or information on the procedure, contact the Land Use Planning office. This decision is not appealable to the Land Use Board of Appeals (LUBA) until all local appeals are exhausted.

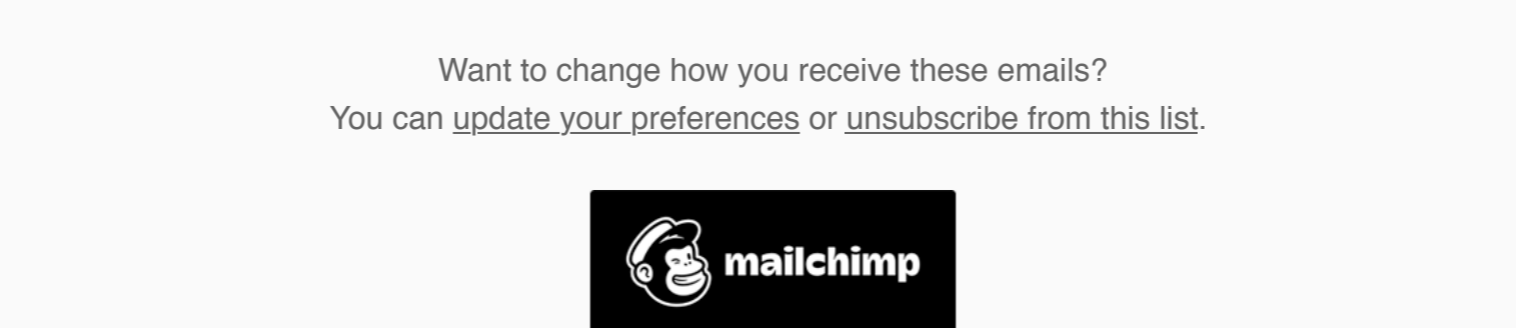
